The school established special relationships with seven supporting parishes - St. Albert the Great, St. John Vianney, St. Margaret Mary, St. Mary Our Lady of the Lake, St. Thomas More, St. Vincent de Paul, and St. William. Holy Family serves over 480 students in Pre-K through 8th grade.
