We pray for the unemployed. Help them guard against discouragement; so that they may emerge from this trial spiritually enriched and with even greater blessings from God.

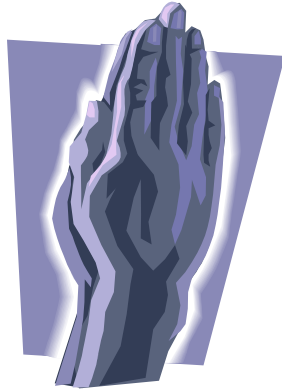
We thank you for those returning to the workplace.
