REL-01.01.01	Show understanding that God is the Creator of all things and "saw that it was good."
REL-01.01.02	Understand that God created us good and cares for us as a loving parent. God made human beings in his own likeness, giving them responsibility for the care of the earth.
REL-01.01.03	Comprehend that we are all created by God and destined to be with him forever.
REL-01.01.04	Show understanding that God reveals himself to us in all of creation.
REL-01.01.05	Comprehend that God is everywhere, all knowing and all loving.
REL-01.01.06	State belief that in one God, there are Three Persons in one God: Father, Son and Holy
REL-01.01.07	State that Jesus is God's Son who was sent by God to teach us how to love one another as his children.
REL-01.01.08	Identify God the Holy Spirit as God's Spirit alive in us and in the Church.
REL-01.01.09	Identify Mary as the Mother of Jesus and the Mother of God.
REL-01.01.10	State meaning of the name of Jesus as "God saves."

REL-01.01.13	Identify the Church as a community of those who believe in God and who ratify that belief in baptism.
REL-01.02.01	State that Jesus Christ instituted the sacraments and gave them to the Church.
REL-01.02.02	Identify sacraments as signs of God's love.
REL-01.02.03	State that we meet Jesus in a special way through the celebration of the sacraments.
REL-01.02.04	State that the Sacrament of Baptism makes us members of the Church.
REL-01.02.05	Identify the matter and form of Baptism.
REL-01.02.06	Describe how when we are baptized we became followers of Jesus Christ: Christians.
REL-01.02.07	Show basic understanding that God forgives us in the Sacrament of Penance/
REL-01.02.08	Exhibit basic recognition of the Sacrament of Eucharist as a sign of Jesus sharing himself with us in a special meal called the Mass.
REL-01.03.01	Show understanding that God created us as good and loving and that we respect and love one another.
REL-01.03.02	State that God gave us the ability to choose what is good and avoid what is wrong.
REL-01.03.03	Exhibit understanding of obedience to others who care for our safety.
REL-01.03.04	Distinguish good habits from bad habits.
REL-01.03.05	State the two great commandments of God and their meaning.
REL-01.03.06	State meaning of virtue.
REL-01.03.07	State meaning of sin.
REL-01.03.08	State meaning of forgiveness and when we need to be forgiven.
REL-01.03.09	Show understanding that all people are respected and appreciated for their gifts of culture, race and language.
REL-01.04.01	Identify the Bible as a sacred book that reveals who God is and his love for us.
REL-01.04.02	Name the Gospels as the good news about Jesus Christ, the Son of God.
REL-01.04.03	Understand that Mary received a message from the Angel Gabriel that she would be the Mother of Jesus Christ, the Son of God.
REL-01.04.04	Identify that Mary's cousins were Elizabeth and Zechariah, who were the parents of John the Baptist.
REL-01.04.05	Identify the Holy Spirit of God in the lives of Mary and Elizabeth.
REL-01.04.06	Describe the birth of Jesus in Bethlehem as written in the Gospel of Luke.

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REL-01.04.07	Describe Jesus as a boy who lived with his family in Nazareth and grew in strength and wisdom just like other children.
REL-01.04.08	State that Jesus taught the people by using stories.
REL-01.04.09	Show understanding that Jesus prayed and taught his friends how to pray.
REL-01.04.10	State that Jesus had power to heal others and raise people from the dead.
REL-01.04.11	State that Jesus had many friends who followed him.
REL-01.04.12	Describe Jesus' resurrection from the dead and appearances to his friends.
REL-01.05.01	Identify the church as a sacred place where we meet God and show God our respect and
REL-01.05.02	Express understanding that when we enter the church we bless ourselves with holy water as a sign of our baptism.
REL-01.05.03	Recognize the altar as the central object in a church. Recognize other sacred objects.

REL-01.05.06	State that the Mass has two main parts: Liturgy of the Word and Liturgy of the Eucharist.

REL-01.05.08	State that the Church celebrates the life of Jesus Christ throughout liturgical cycle.
