REL-02.05.03	Identify confession of sin, contrition, absolution and penance in Reconciliation.
REL-02.05.04	Show familiarity with the Rite of the Sacrament of Penance/ Reconciliation.

REL-02.05.06	Exhibit understanding that Mass is a time of thanksgiving and petition.

REL-02.05.08	Identify the Penitential Rite as a time to show sorrow for sin & ask for forgiveness.
REL-02.05.09	Identify the Gloria as a song of praise to the Holy Trinity.
REL-02.05.10	Identify the components of the Liturgy of the Word and prayer responses.
REL-02.05.11	Identify the Prayer of the Faithful as the final part of the Liturgy of the Word.
REL-02.05.12	Recognize components of Liturgy of the Eucharist: Preparation of the Altar and Gifts, Offering, Eucharistic Prayer, Communion & Prayer after Communion.
REL-02.05.13	Understand that gifts are presented to God in praise and thanksgiving.
REL-02.05.14	Show understanding that during Eucharistic prayer, using the words of Jesus, the priest consecrates the bread and wine and they become the Body and Blood of Christ.
REL-02.05.15	Memorize ritual prayer responses of Liturgy of the Eucharist.
REL-02.05.16	Demonstrate understanding of Sign of Peace.
REL-02.05.17	Exhibit reverence for Communion as the Real Presence of Jesus.
REL-02.05.18	Exhibit understanding that Mass ends with sending forth to do good works.
REL-02.05.19	Describe the role of the priest/celebrant at Mass.
REL-02.05.20	Identify seasons of the Liturgical Year.
