Highlighting Eucharistic Miracles

During the 25th Anniversary, Holy Family Catholic School celebrated the Food for the Journey: a study of 10 Eucharistic Miracles worldwide.

From Krakow, Poland in 1345, where Consecrated Hosts emitted a bright light from a marsh after they were hidden by thieves, to a priest in Spain in 1348, who fell into the water carrying Consecrated Hosts.

The priest heard fishermen calling his name, only to learn that fish in the water were coming up to the top with the discs in their mouths, which were the Hosts. The Hosts were immediately recovered and brought back to the church in a solemn procession in which the whole village participated.

Holy Family students reenacted this scene (depicted on the cover) during the Eucharistic Miracle exhibit supported by the Angel Fund.



PSIA UPDATE

Holy Family congratulates all of the students who participated in PSIA competitions this year! Both Elementary and Middle School teams placed third overall. Eighteen students, outlined in the June Sentinel, placed in the top 10 of their individual categories.

We began administering the NWEA Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) assessments four years ago to track student achievement and growth over time. These nationally normed assessments provide a snapshot into how our students are progressing compared to peers across the country and within the Diocese of Austin.


This year, we are proud to highlight the exceptional performance of the Class of 2025, whose MAP scores from 5th through 8th grade reflect not only their hard work and resilience, but also the strength of our academic program and the dedication of our faculty.

A Four-Year Journey of Growth

The following charts illustrate the average MAP scores for Holy Family students in Math, Reading, Language, and Science, compared to national norms and diocesan averages where available in the fall over the last 4 years.


Math

Holy Family's Class of 2025 consistently outpaced national and diocesan averages in Math, culminating in an 8th-grade average of 240, a full 15 points above the national mean.




Reading

Reading scores reflect strong literacy development, with students achieving an 8th-grade average of 230, compared to 218 nationally and 226.6 within the Diocese.




<u>Language</u>

In Language, our students demonstrated consistent growth and mastery of grammar, writing, and communication skills, finishing 8th grade with an average of 228.9.



Science


Science scores were equally impressive, with Holy Family students achieving an 8th-grade average of 225.8, well above both national and diocesan benchmarks.



n May 21, our school held its first-ever Middle School Extravaganza, a full-day event designed to celebrate leadership, friendship, and the powerful sense of community that has grown through the new House System for middle school students.

Launched this year as a way to build strong relationships, the students were split into advisories. During the year, a focus group of students helped form this new initiative. Based on their feedback, the advisories were split into Houses. The four houses were Justice, Temperance, Prudence, and Fortitude. Over the course of the year, houses earned points for everything from attending games to leading schoolwide service efforts. The faculty leadership team developed the Extravaganza to serve as the capstone to our advisory program and House Competition.

The day began with an Opening Ceremony, complete with upbeat music, Minute-to-Win-It warm-ups, and lots of cheering. From there, students dove into the Leadership Academy, a morning of workshops designed to equip rising 7th and 8th graders with practical skills for leadership and service.

Sixth graders rotated through sessions on topics like organization, goal setting, community care, and writing a letter to a rising 6th grader about what to expect in middle school. Meanwhile, seventh graders split into groups to explore deeper topics such as servant leadership, kindness, belonging, and preparing for high school. Led by a dynamic team of teachers and mentors, these sessions laid the foundation for a stronger, more intentional student body.

After a spirited lunch and recess, it was time for what many students had been waiting for: House Games and Competitions. The gym and fields were buzzing with energy as students faced off in a Kickball Championship.

Each house participated in two rounds of kickball. Then, the students went to the gym where they competed in trivia, relay races, marshmallow engineering, "David and Goliath" spoon game, and knock-out. The top three finishers earned additional points, adding tension and excitement to the overall house standings.

The final match of the day was the Championship Kickball Game, which determined the athletic victors. The closing ceremony ended the day with the announcement that Justice had won the first-ever House championship. They won pizza the following day, along with a shield that will be proudly displayed in the Hope Building next year.

As the sun set on this extraordinary day, one thing was clear: leadership is alive and well in our middle school, and this new tradition has only just begun.

Corporal Works of Mercy at Holy Family



In response to hurricanes that impacted schools in the fall of 2024, students raised funds through a bake sale and dress-down day. They supported five schools:

- Diocese of Charlotte: Asheville Catholic School, Canongate Catholic High School, and Immaculata Catholic School
- **Diocese of Venice:** St. Joseph Catholic School (Bradenton, FL) and Bishop Verot Catholic High School (Fort Myers, FL)

Faculty and staff baked over 25 dozen treats, and the middle school "No-Bake Club" contributed as well. Faith in Action students organized the sale, raising a total of \$4,413.30. Each school received \$882.86.

And, for **California Fire Relief**: A spirited penny war raised \$2,641.99 for Catholic schools affected by wildfires in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles.

March for Life: Funds raised at the Angel Invitational concession stand helped send students and families to the Texas Catholic Pro-Life Day in Austin.

Baby Shower for Radiance Women's Center: Students raised funds and hosted a joyful baby shower, gifting essential items to a mother in need.

Your Dollars at Work



In addition to the new religious manipulatives, new instructional resources, <u>Experience Science</u>, makes science fun, inclusive, and hands-on for students in second through eighth grades. In addition to the textbook and digital resources, we were able to purchase lab materials for Grades 2-8 to support hands-on science, instead of just reading about it. These kits (some small parts depicted here) include non-consumable items & tools, as well as consumable materials which will need to be replaced each year.









Appreciating Tuition Assistance

There was a young boy attending a Catholic grade school. He had no idea, at the time, how much it cost or the sacrifices his parents had to make to send him there. All he knew was that he learned a lot, prayed a lot, and that his friends were there because their parents wanted them there too. His parents were Jack and Barb, and he was the sixth of seven children who went to Catholic school.

It wasn't until he was in high school that he learned about the faith, hope, love, and the commitment his parents had to continuously send him to a Catholic school starting in first grade. He also learned, at that time, that others had helped his parents with some of the cost of tuition over the years. Although the support was small, it was impactful, as their family budget was very tight and the "incidentals" of school supplies, book fees, uniforms, lunches, etc., added to the burden. You see, his mom stayed home to raise seven kids while his dad, a self-employed barber, walked to his shop every day, through all the seasons of weather in Ohio, to make enough money to pay the bills, feed the family, and somehow send them to Catholic school. The family was at the poverty line. The parents never took a vacation. They drove their car until it no longer worked. There were no extras. His father wore his black work shoes every day until the soles wore out. They were financially poor, but rich in spirit, faith, and love for God and family.

During his Senior year, second semester, he decided to work at his school, after classes, as an assistant custodian. His friends, teachers, and some others did not understand why. He was the Class President, Honor Society President, Captain of the football and wrestling teams, and the lead character in the spring musical. He simply said, "I want to give back to my school for all it has given me." He also wanted to give back to his parents for all they had given him too. He saved the nominal money earned from this job, and when he gave it to his parents on the day he graduated from that Catholic high school, no words were needed. The money was in a card that simply said, "Thank you for your love of God and for your love for me."

I share my story with you as one example of how a community that supports parents desiring to send their children to a Catholic school needs to know that their gift, no matter the size, impacts the life and soul of those who receive it. Not just now, but for a lifetime.

Thank you for your generosity. Know that each application for assistance is received and reviewed with respect, confidentiality, and prayer. I honor my parents and my Catholic school foundation through our efforts to raise money in support of tuition assistance each year.

That boy was me. My name is Tim Cullen, son of Jack and Barb Cullen. A Catholic school student who benefited from the support of those who cared, who gave, and who impacted a life, a soul.

Thank you for doing the same for the students and families we serve here at Holy Family.







Matthew Pettinato Endowment



August 26, 2025, will mark the tenth-year remembrance of the day Holy Family student, Matthew Pettinato, went to heaven after a multi-year battle with leukemia. Matthew was dearly loved not only by his family and friends but by the administration, faculty, staff, and students of Holy Family Catholic School.

Matthew's Parents, Lisa and Chris Pettinato, shared their painful journey with families in attendance at the Holy Family 25th Anniversary Gala, marking the introduction of the Matthew Pettinato Endowment Fund.

A Tuition Assistance fund was initially created shortly after Matthew's passing with the anticipation that it would be utilized to help others attend Holy Family. Those funds have now been transferred into the newly formed Endowment Fund.

Thanks to your generosity, the Matthew Pettinato Endowment Fund raised \$319,475 during the Fund-a-Need portion of the Holy Family Catholic School's 25th Anniversary Gala including pledges to be paid out over time. The Catholic Foundation of the Diocese of Austin is now managing the fund. The first deposit of \$230,000 has been made.


