Pre-Kindergarten Overview

Pre-Kindergarten (Pre-K) provides the foundation to help students become lifelong learners. As they explore the world around them, students learn how to make new friends, share, and problem solve. Students learn about their faith through song, story, prayer, and play. They join the whole school for weekly Mass and monthly Adoration, where they sit with an 8th grade Mass mentor. In the classroom, students engage in self-directed and center-based learning as they develop reading readiness and math readiness skills to include the alphabet, numbers, shapes, and colors. Students also have opportunities to develop fine and gross motor skills through writing, tracing, cutting, climbing, and building. One memorable experience includes a visit from a petting zoo where students learn about the animals.
