Lectio Award Books count for Summer Reading in Grades 4 – 8 and you can read a Lectio Book and take the quiz INSTEAD of doing ONE OF THE projects. So, you can begin your Lectio Awards program AND earn credit for Summer Reading all at the same time.

1. Read one of the 2022—2023 Lectio Books—the list is below

You can read more and take the quizzes, but only one book counts toward Summer Reading. Be prepared to give a short oral-presentation about the book if your teacher asks.

- 2. As soon as you finish your Lectio Book, REQUEST A QUIZ from the Google Classroom
- 3. Take the quiz between August 1 and August 19! Within 24 hours you will be notified in email of your results.

If you earn 7/10 points or more, you earn credit for Summer Reading and the Lectio Awards Program. If you earn 6/10 or less, you will need to pick a Summer Reading Project to do instead.

*How to Sign in to the Lectio Google Classroom and request a quiz

If you participated last year, you already have the Lectio Google Classroom. Access it and you'll see all the new books. The quizzes will be available on August 1st.

If you are new to Lectio this year follow the steps —it takes a little patience to get started.

1. On a laptop or computer log in to your HFCS school account (very important step)

Access YOUR Google Classroom account from MY APPS

Use the "+" to add a new class

Type in the Google Classroom Code: 4mrlmgo

You should see the Lectio Google Classroom STREAM page

2. Click the "CLASSWORK" tab

Under "KEY INFORMATION" you will see "REQUEST A QUIZ"

Open the Google Form and fill out the relevant information and click "submit"

Wait up to 24 hours as the quiz is manually sent from me and is not auto-generated

3. Access your quiz from your Holy Family Outlook Email Inbox

Open Outlook email from your MY APPS (this step is so important)

You will need to check your junk mail as my first emails end up there until I am a trusted recipient

Please have your parents help you if you are unfamiliar with email

4. Please wait up to 24 hours for me to grade your quiz and give notice to your teacher of your success!
