Grades 2-4

1. Students read two books from the list *or* one from the list and one book of their choice

2. Independent reading, reading with a parent, parent read aloud, or audio books are encouraged

3. When possible, please let your child choose the books

4. Student-crafted projects are due Monday, August 22 which is the second week of school

Grade 4 option: Instead of doing a project, you may read a Lectio Awards book and take a quiz; be prepared to give a short oral presentation about your Lectio book in class

Grades 5-8

1. Read the assigned book for the grade level

Independent reading and audio books are allowed

Complete a project from the list provided

Even though an entire series is suggested, only one book from the series is required
