Tuition Assistance Program

Holy Family has a long history of offering tuition assistance for families in need. We are committed to offering the possibility of a Catholic education to as many students as possible. Unlike a parish-owned school, Holy Family Catholic School must be self-sufficient for our annual operating costs. As a result, we must place some limits on the total funds available for tuition assistance. To keep the award process both fair and confidential, the school contracts with an independent company for the analysis of financial need.

FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment

FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment will be conducting the financial need analysis for Holy Family for the 2025-2026 school year. Families applying for financial aid will need to complete an application and submit the necessary supporting documentation to FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment on or before February 21, 2025 for consideration in the first round of awards. The Grant & Aid Assessment application is available in your current FACTS account.

The following information is **required** for FACTS Grant & Aid to process your application.

- Submit a completed online application. Please do not submit multiple applications. FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment will process one application per household. The FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment application can be accessed within your FACTS account.
- A non-refundable fee of \$40.00 is required prior to sending your supporting documents.
- Copies of your 2023 or 2024 IRS Federal Form 1040, 1040A or 1040-EZ U.S. Individual Income Tax Return (2 pages), including all supporting tax Schedules C or C-EZ, Schedule E, Schedule F, Depreciation Form 4562, S Corporation Form 1120S (4 pages) & Schedule K-1. If applicant and co-applicant file separately, both tax returns for the same tax year are required.
- Copies of all 2024 W-2 Wage and Tax Statements for both you and your spouse.
- Copies of all supporting documentation for household Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation, and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF).

Please allow 3 to 4 weeks for your application to be processed. Be sure to check the primary e-mail address listed on your electronic application for notices sent by FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment indicating missing information or tax documents. NOTE: Award decisions are not made by FACTS Grant & Aid Assessments, but by the Business & Finance Counsel of North Central Catholic School Corporation d/b/a Holy Family Catholic School. Family information remains anonymous to the Counsel. **All applications submitted by February 21st will receive notification letters before the end of March. Applications received after February 21st will be notified on an individual basis if funds are still available.**

Important Dates to Remember:

- **By February 21** Send all required documents and pay online the \$40 fee to FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment. Expect to hear the results of your application by mid-March. Awards for tuition assistance are for the 2025-2026 school year only. In order to be considered for tuition assistance next year, you must submit the appropriate application and documentation starting January of 2026. Identical awards from year to year cannot be assumed.
- **By April 18** If you do not receive an award of tuition assistance that is the amount you requested, you may appeal by writing a letter(to the attention of Mrs. Nguyen) explaining any additional or changed circumstances.
