






# Organization Chart

#### **EXAMPLES OF INCIDENCES**

#### ISOLATED INCIDENT

- Physical or Verbal Altercation between two students
- Bullying incident
- Health scare issue
- Child being disruptive in class
- Child causes property damage

#### COHORT

A cohort is defined as a group of students. This may be one homeroom, class, or a grade level. It could also be a larger group such as the "middle school" or the students in a building.

- Playground altercation involving multiple students
- Safety incident in which multiple students were at risk
- An incident that affects one class/team, but not the whole grade or school

- Severe Weather Incident
- School Closure





The Board of Advisors met on August 3rd to review the plan overview.

IN RECENT YEARS, WE HAVE ENSURED THAT OUR TEACHERS MAKE AT LEAST 90% OF WHAT RRISD SCHOOL TEACHERS MAKE – ALMOST A 10% INCREASE OVER THE PAST 2 YEARS


- Top Notch Academic Programs PSIA District Champions, Texas State Science Fair award winners, first place in PSIA One Act Play last year.


