President's Welcome



Dear Holy Family Community,

The 2023-2024 school year concluded with the commencement of our 8th grade class to high school, and then we transitioned into planning mode to prepare for 2024-2025. It was a year of many highlights that are shared within this annual report. A few items are listed below:

- We welcomed two assistant principals to the leadership team; Mrs. Morley and Miss Masanda started building positive relationships with all stakeholders and are excited to continue this momentum.
- The “School within a School” was initiated and provided increased opportunities for collaboration, communication, and focus within our PreK – 4th, and 5th – 8th grade settings.
- Families received over \$500,000 in tuition assistance support from the school.
- Faculty received a raise and an annual step increase at 90% of the Round Rock ISD scale.
- Staff received a 5% percent increase in their pay rate.
- The “Fund a Need” from the Gala generated resources for the purchase of a full-size golf cart which was received in May. This vehicle will provide accessibility to those needing assistance and mobility and for our security officer to patrol the campus each day. The remaining funds will be used to purchase the school’s first van for off-campus activities.
- The Student Success Center was implemented and staffed to serve students with various needs.
- The first HFCS “Kid’s College” was established with well-attended sessions over two weeks.
- The “Build the Future” plan was initiated for strategic planning purposes for the next five years. The plan outline was released last Spring and is being shared.
- We entered into a collaborative agreement with St. Vincent de Paul for Chaplaincy services.

Another update on the status of our school will be included in the first quarter edition of “The Sentinel.” We have several initiatives in the works and look forward to increasing our outreach to serve families who want a Catholic school home for their children. We thank you for your support, prayers, and trust in our Catholic school. Please reach out to us if you have any questions or would like to get involved in the journey of our school with your time, talents, and treasures.

Principal's Address

Dear Family and Friends,

This past year, Holy Family circled around the theme: Walk with Mary. Over the year, our community grew in faith by reflecting on one Marian apparition per month. This included several opportunities to reflect on our Blessed Mother as well as the Balloon Rosary, praying the Dolor Rosary together, and bringing our community together for the May Crowning led by our 2nd grade students.

The year was marked with many great accomplishments and activities. Here are some of our highlights from the 2023-2024 school year.

We created a Leadership Team and a Liturgy Team to support communication and collaboration at Holy Family. These teams led grade level discussions throughout the year, instituted monthly Adoration for our school community, and facilitated additional Confession opportunities for middle school students.

Our community celebrated the completion of the Wisdom Building and moved all teachers into permanent classrooms. This gave everyone a home and allowed for the creation of the Student Success Center in Charity, which is dedicated to supporting students with various needs.

We enjoyed the amazing expansion and engagement of our Library Services for all students, including immersive, multi-media experiences, and new opportunities for families to engage within that setting.


We saw increased opportunities for parents to come together on campus as a community, such as the first "Taste of the World" cultural fair and the "STEM Night."

The increased support for faculty and staff through professional development, funded by the previous Gala, through coaching, weekly meetings with administration and learning support, and the expansion of the aligned phonics program "Foundations" through grade 2.

We instituted a Mentor Program for new faculty and staff at Holy Family which provided year-long guidance, support, and collaboration during the first year of employment.

This year, there was increased student and parent participation in the Private Schools Interscholastic Association (PSIA) which led to great performances at the state competitions. The One Act Play Troupe placed first in the state competition this year. Students also placed first in the state for their grade level in Oral Interpretation and Ready Writing. The elementary PSIA team placed third at the state competition.

As we embark on our 25th Anniversary for the 2024-2025 school year, I am hopeful that we will continue to foster future saints as we remember the past, celebrate the present, and plan for the future. As we conclude one year and prepare for the next year, I cannot wait to see what God has in store for Holy Family Catholic School!

The average annual gift to the Angel Fund increased by 37% over the previous year, and our average gift saw a 16% increase. Our gala set new fundraising records, enabling us to purchase a 6-passenger golf cart and begin the process of acquiring a school van for the 2024-2025 school year. Additionally, our "Run With the Angels" peer-to-peer fundraising event not only exceeded its goal but also helped us engage donors beyond our immediate parent community.

I extend my heartfelt thanks to each parent, grandparent, alumni family, board member, faculty and staff member, corporation, foundation, and friend of Holy Family for your invaluable contributions. 

For the 2023-24 academic year, Holy Family awarded more than \$576,615 in need-based financial aid to 89 families, encompassing 151 of our students.






Third Place in the "AA" State Meet Elementary Division


STATEMENT OF REVENUES



The Angel Fund

The Angel Fund annual appeal plays a crucial role in bridging the gap between the actual cost of educating each student and the tuition paid by families. This year, with 27% family participation, we not only met our goal of \$330,000 but exceeded it, raising a total of \$344,789, net of expenses.

The Gap Explained

With these funds, this past year, the Angel Fund has made a significant impact, bringing several key initiatives to fruition:

- **Ensuring Access:** Funds to ensure qualified students have access to a Holy Family education.
- **Competitive Salaries:** A significant increase in teacher and staff salaries, aligning with RRISD annual increases.
- **Professional Development:** Investment in the professional development and recruitment of faculty and staff.
- **Enhanced Learning Materials:** Upgraded textbooks, workbooks and other consumables, and novel sets were purchased to elevate the educational experience.
- **Student Support:** An additional full-time staff member was added in our Student Success Center to better serve learners at every level.
- **Classroom Supplies:** A dedicated classroom supply budget of \$250 was offered to each homeroom teacher.
- **Grandparents Day:** A special day was planned and executed to welcome our grandparents on to campus.
- **Creative Resources:** Provisions of clay, art supplies, and STEM resources were purchased.
- **Athletics:** New branding and a new logo, and 7th and 8th grade uniforms were purchased.
