Why do we need an annual appeal?

The remaining 10-20% - often called the "GAP" - is raised through fundraising. The Choir of Angels annual fund appeal helps to control tuition increases and allows each family to take advantage of the tax benefit of their gift. This model makes Catholic education affordable to all families in our community, while supplying funding for daily needs such as technology, classroom materials, staff development, and facility maintenance. The GAP amount for 2021-2022 is \$1,100 per student.

Donor participation is a crucial factor looked at by organizations providing grants and potential benefactors interested in funding the school so, participation is key!
