## 2023 Summer Reading Project Choices

Character Virtues	Choose your favorite character. Create an image that shows how your character portrays a Catholic Virtue. Write a few sentences to explain your project.
Shoebox Diorama	Choose your favorite scene and make a diorama about it. Be sure to include background pictures that show the setting and the characters who were in the scene.
Alternate Ending for the book	Change the ending to something you like better! Make sure it's really different from what the author wrote. Write at least three pages. Be sure to include dialogue (talking characters), exciting action or a problem that the characters need to fix, and a solution to that action or problem.
Book Review	Convince your friends whether to read the book or not. Be honest about the good and bad things about the book. Turn in a typed copy of your review. Be sure to include a short summary (3-4 sentences), one or two good things about the book, and one or two bad thing about the book.
Sequel Summary	Think the story should have continued after the book was over? Write a summary of the sequel. Include: How the sequel starts out, information about the old and new characters, setting, plot summary, including exciting action or a problem that the characters need to fix, how the book will end.
Creative Artwork	Choose a scene, a character, or the setting and turn it into art! You can make a painting, a photo collage, a sculpture – whatever you can imagine! You can use any type of art material that you want – clay, Legos, paints, colored pencils, scrapbook paper, etc. The artwork that you turn in will be displayed.

Illustrative Summary	Briefly summarize the story in five complete sentences. Then write one or two sentences that explains the most beautiful thing that happened in the story. In the next paragraph, write a few sentences that explains which character in the book portrays a Catholic Virtue. Create a one-page illustration that shows this character in a scene from the book displaying this virtue.
Talk Show	Video yourself and a friend acting out the interview script.

Your interview should have at least 10 questions and answers. The character's answers should be based off of the book and your imagination about how he or she would act. Turn in typed questions, answers and video of your interview. For turning in your video, please save on a USB flash drive and turn in to teacher. You may also try emailing your video to your new teacher or sharing via Google Drive but know that the file might be too large to upload.

Just like a movie trailer gets you excited for a new movie; a book trailer can get your friends excited about a new book!

Just don't give away the ending! Video tape yourself talking about the book. Hold up the book, pictures of the book's pictures (if there are any), pictures that represent things happening in the book, etc. Turn in a written copy of your script and your video.

Include: A quick summary, your favorite thing about the book, exciting parts of the story, a "conclusion" that tells the audience why they should read the book. For turning in your video, please save on a USB flash drive and turn in to teacher or share via Google Drive.
